## The New 2024 Recommended Immunization Schedules Now Online!

The 2024 ACIP Recommended Immunization Schedules are now posted online. As a reminder, the schedules summarize final recommendations that were previously adopted and made official by the CDC director. Therefore, these schedules are effective immediately. Updates: Changes in the app are released through app updates.


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
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

## **Key Highlights**

The COVID-19 note was revised to provide guidance for use of updated (2023–2024 Formula) COVID-19 vaccines.

The DTaP note was revised to clarify primary and booster doses.

The influenza note has been added clarifying persons with a history of egg allergy of any severity CAN be vaccinated with any influenza vaccine indicated for the recipient's age and health status with no additional safety considerations.

The MMR note was updated to clarify when MMRV is used for routine, catch-up vaccination, or in "Special situations", the minimum interval between doses is 3 months.

MenACWY-D (Menactra) has been removed from all sections. Menactra has been removed because this product is no longer distributed in the United States.

The Tdap note was revised to clarify that the Tdap dose recommended at age 11–12 years is the adolescent Tdap booster dose.
